Artist Requirements

Each applicant is required to submit three quality slides representational of current work to be exhibited at the Festival and a fourth slide of booth display and presentation (or the same on a CD). All work must be original: designed and created by the artist.

Fees

A \$15.00 non-refundable jury fee will be charged. The booth fee is \$225.00. Both checks must be enclosed with application to be eligible for jurying. The booth fee check will be deposited after May 15th, if accepted. No refunds after June 30th, 2010.

Exhibit Space

Artists receive a 10' x 10' ground space. Booths will be set up in the center of Haddon Avenue. Artists must provide their own canopy and display which should be designed for outdoor use and be able to be enclosed on all sides for overnight security. Display must be contained in the 10'x10' area. There is no vending or storage on sidewalks adjacent to booths.
